

Web Scripting Midterm Project Guidelines

The midterm project is an opportunity for you to demonstrate what you have learned in HTML, CSS and XHTML. You are required to create a minimum of four web pages that comprise a site. This site's is your choice, but keep in mind that a project that is presentable in an interview will only help you get the job you want.

The basic structure of your site should contain:

- Home page (with main navigation)
- Three sub-pages (with links back to the main page)

Please employ the design fundamentals you have learned in prior classes.

The design of your site must contain at least:

- A consistent set of colors and design aesthetics between each page
- One image on each page
- 2 links on each page (1 should always return to the home page)
- A mailto link on at least one page
- A background image on at least one page
- A transparent image on at least one page (gif or png)
- An animated image on at least one page
- A table to effect the layout of images and text
- A layer to effect the layout of images and text

Each project must also make use of the following elements and attributes:

- Table element
- Div element
- Div (as layer) element
- P or PRE element
- UL or OL (and LI) element
- Style attribute (i.e. use CSS) element
- Title and Head element
- A element

All sites must look similar in Internet Explorer and Mozilla's Firefox.

All pages are to be generated using a text editor. Using Dreamweaver, FrontPage or similar programs is prohibited.
